

## Head of Mission - Trainee Program 2025

The Head of Mission (HoM) Trainee Program is a series of lectures organized over two days to ensure comprehensive preparation for the HoM position. The HoM Trainee Program is organized by the SAROPS Unit and addresses prospective candidates interested in participating in the HoM position for Sea-Eye. Given the complex nature of the position and the extensive profile of requirements, the HoM Trainee Program is a collaborative effort conducted by several units: Legal, Medics, Post-Rescue Team, Communications, and SAROPS. During the program, each unit will hold up to one hour of presentation to cover aspects that are most relevant from their perspective for the day-to-day work of the HoM position during a mission. This allocated time also provides an opportunity for HoM candidates to raise questions, which are answered from various perspectives. The aim of the program is to transfer knowledge and sensitize candidates to the multifaceted conflict dynamics onboard. By attending the program, candidates should be able to make operational decisions that are carefully considered and can incorporate the perspectives and needs of the other teams onboard.
