# Maritime SAR Operations Coordinator with Medical Focus (f/m/d)

We are a civilian aid organisation founded in 2015 in response to people dying in the Mediterranean Sea. We search for people in distress on the world's deadliest refugee route and fight against the daily loss of life at sea with our rescue boat. We are convinced:

"Every life counts!"

The SAROPS Department (Search and Rescue Operations) is responsible for the strategic planning and practical implementation of Sea-Eye's rescue missions at sea. This position combines operational coordination with a medical focus. Ideally, you are based in Germany and available to work regularly in our Berlin office.

#### **RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Support and coordination of ongoing rescue missions from shore, including active participation in the Director-of-Mission on-call rotation, ensuring 24/7 availability for the vessel's command team.
- Coordination of the medical team, including operational preparation, crew support, development and evaluation of standardized medical trainings, and logistics related to the onboard hospital.
- Continuous improvement of communication and operational processes within mission coordination.
- Participation in and occasional organization of team meetings (mostly digital).
- Willingness to travel within Germany and internationally, as well as occasional weekend work.

#### **PROFILE**

- Strong interest and understanding of sea rescue, flight, and migration issues.
- Experience in team leadership, process design, and coordination—ideally including working with volunteers.
- Knowledge of maritime operations, emergency medical services, or similar professional fields.
- Medical qualification, e.g. as a paramedic, nurse, or equivalent.
- Flexibility regarding working hours, including evening availability and on-call



- duties, as well as occasional travel (e.g. ship visits).
- High level of self-initiative, organizational skills, and the ability to remain calm and focused in crisis situations.
- Excellent command of English (spoken and written); ideally also good German and Italian skills.
- Previous mission or maritime experience is an advantage.

#### WHAT WE OFFER

- Flexible working hours and mobile work options within Germany, with available workspaces in Regensburg, Berlin, Hamburg, Leipzig, and Munich.
- An annual training budget (50% of one monthly salary).
- An annual health budget (via supplementary company health insurance) and employer-supported pension scheme with an attractive contribution.
