Engineer – SAR Vessel Operations(f/m/d)

We are a civilian aid organization founded in 2015 in response to people dying in the Mediterranean Sea. We search for people in distress on the world's deadliest refugee route and fight against the daily loss of life at sea with our rescue boat. We are convinced:

If you share our belief in solidarity at sea and want to put your technical expertise to meaningful use, we look forward to your application.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Ensure the safe and efficient operation of all propulsion systems and auxiliary machinery onboard.
- Oversee, maintain, and troubleshoot hydraulic, cooling, and fuel systems.
- Perform basic electrical work, including diagnostics and maintenance of lowvoltage systems.
- Support onboard safety by adhering to marine procedures and participating in firstaid readiness.
- Assist with deck operations when required, contributing to the vessel's overall mission readiness.

PROFILE

- Marine Engineering certification or equivalent practical experience in vessel engineering.
- Strong knowledge of propulsion, auxiliary machinery, and mechanical systems
- Basic electrical skills, including hands-on experience with low-voltage systems.
- Familiarity with maritime safety processes; first-aid skills are desirable.
- Experience with high-speed rescue vessels or SAR operations is highly valued



- Physically fit and comfortable assisting with deck duties.
- Strong situational awareness, teamwork, and communication abilities.
- Fluent English; Italian and/or Arabic language skills are an advantage.
- Willingness to contribute to additional technical roles such as basic electrical support
- Proactive mindset with resilience and problem-solving capacity
